CALL TO ORDER: President Kyle Hackett called the meeting to order at 10:30 A.M.

OPEN WITH PRAYER: Pastor Dave Stroschein opened with prayer.

READING OF MISSION STATEMENT: The Mission Statement was read by Joan Ramey.

INTRODUCTION: President Kyle Hackett read the Introduction Statement.

READING AND APPROVAL OF 2021 MINUTES: Secretary Bev Gerads read the minutes of the 2021 Congregational Meeting. Bruce Resch made a motion to accept the minutes as read and Lois Perleberg second. Motion Passed. The congregation reviewed the minutes from the February 6, 2022 There will be special meeting and Voters Meeting Oct 30. There were no questions. Deb Erdmann made a motion to approve, Dave Perleberg seconded.

A QUORUM IS DECLARED. Vice President Dave Perleberg read the qualifications for elections of BOLM members. Our nominations for BOLM new terms are Deb Erdmann, Dave Perleberg and Paul Tschida. Kyle Hackett asked the congregation if there were any other nominations 3 times. Sara Anderson closed the nominations. The congregation was instructed to vote for 2. The vacant seat of Garry Loidolt was open for a 1-year term. Deb Erdmann and Dave Perleberg were elected to new terms and Paul Tschida will fill the 1 yr. term. Bruce Resch made a motion to destroy the ballots, Deb Erdmann second.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Ron McKeever presented the 2022 Treasurer's report. Right now we are not paying a full Pastor's salary. We are operating in the black. This will change when we have secured a new full time Pastor. Ron asked if there were any questions from the congregation. Motion made by Dave Perleberg, second by Candace Dingmann to accept the Treasurer's report. Thank you to Curt and Julie for making sure the vouchers are signed properly, and to Janet Maleska and Barb McKeever for helping with the audit. Thank you to Curt for all of his dedicated help.

CALL PROCESS: We were informed that our Pastoral call was declined. This is what it entails. President Brady Finnern will generate a list. Pastor Dave will contact the President to come to SOTP at which time we will decide either to call a seminarian or go back to the call field. Some questions regarding a time frame in doing this procedure were rendered.

NEW BUSINESS: Audit was completed. Our budget was explained. Inflation will somewhat affect us. 2023 includes a new pastor, resurface of the parking lot this summer sometime. We do have money in the checkbook to pay for the resurfacing. Scott Manea mentioned chip seal and restripe. We will also move some parking places closer and install a handrail. Bruce Resch made a motion to accept the 2023 budget, Peg Manea second.

A person was needed to attend the synod conference. Bruce Resch will cast a ballot for Synod President. Ministry reports have been presented each month. No new presentations at this time. Janet Maleska thanked Kyle for his work, the congregation applauded.

MOTION TO ADJOURN: Ron McKeever made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Duane Ott, second. Meeting adjourned at 11:01 A.M.


