Dear sisters and brothers in Christ!

SHEPHERD OF THE PINES LUTHERAN CHURCH ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING NOVEMBER 19, 2023

President Kyle Hackett called the meeting to order to 10:30am. Pastor Dave Stroschein opened with prayer. Joanny Ramey read Mission Statement. Kyle Hackett read the introduction statement.

Acting Secretary Deb Erdmann read the minutes of the 2022 Congregational Meeting. Bruce Resch motioned to accept the minutes as read and second by Roxanne Peterson. Motion passed. The congregation reviewed the minutes from March 5, 2023 and June 25, 2023 Special Congregational Meetings along with the minutes from the September 17, 2023 Pastoral Call Voters Meeting. There were no questions. Bruce Resch made a motion to approve the minutes as presented in lieu of reading Ron McKeever second. Motion passed.

President Kyle Hackett read the qualifications for elections of BOLM members. Ron McKeever was the only nomination for Treasure. Kyle Hackett asked the congregation if there were any other nominations 3 times. Bill Paradeis closed the nominations and called for a unanimous vote followed by a second from Bruce Resch. Motion passed. President Kyle explained that in the by-laws the BOLM must consist of at least 4 men. Nominations for the 3-year term are Paul Tschida and Josh Anderson. Kyle asked 3 times if there were any other nominations. Seeing none Jim Amundson made a motion to close nominations and called for a unanimous vote. Keith Hackett second. Motion passed. Nominations for the other 3-year term were Richael Weinand, Janet Maleska and Joanny Ramey. Kyle Hackett asked the congregation if there were any other nominations 3 times. Bruce Resch made a motion to close the nominations and Ron McKeever seconded it. Motion passed and ballets were passed out.

Treasures Report: Ron McKeever wanted to express great thanks to Curt Kvamme for all he does. Janet Maleska and Barb McKeever completed the audit. Ron reported we are still in the black but that's with no full time Pastor salary. Thanks go out to Julie Kiraly and Curt Kvamme for keeping things running smoothly. Keith Hackett motioned to accept the Treasurers report and Dennis Arntson seconded it. Motion passed.

New Business: The budget was explained. Inflation is up. The cost of lawn mowing and snow removal is up. To meet our currant budget we need \$4700 per week and to meet our 2024 budget we'll need \$5300 coming in weekly. Going forward increase your donation would be appreciated. When calling a Pastor we need to be above the middle line for salary. Looking at \$100,000- \$150,000 per year plus family insurance and retirement package. Bruce moved to accept the budget report. Peg Manea second. Motion passed. Call Process: There is a meeting tonight. Narrowed down to 4 Pastors.

Properties: Keith Peterson reported the parking lot project is completed. He's looking to replace windows in the choir room and the nursery next year. Windows are running about \$600 each. If anyone has an idea for a bigger project let Keith know. Sometimes it takes awhile to budget for that. Scott Manea inquired on the shingles and Keith said they were good.

Worship Team Leader: Keith Hackett asked if you're not already volunteering please consider it. We always need more help. The music videos are pulled from online and the volume may be a little off on them.

Bruce Resch wanted to express appreciation to Kyle for all he's done.

The votes were in and Joanny Ramey will continue on the BOLM.

Peg Manea motioned to destroy the ballets and Bruce Resch second. Motion passed

Duane Ott moved to adjourn the meeting and Art Betker second. Meeting adjourned 11:04 AM.

Pastor Dave Stroschein closed with prayer.


