Pastor: God has called us into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord. And He is faithful.

Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: Listen to this Word of the Lord from 1 John as it speaks to us about being in fellowship with God and with one another. "If we walk in the light, as He is light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, His son, purifies us from all sin. If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:7-9) Together let us make confession of our sins.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, I cannot claim to be without sin. My own conscience convicts me as does the Holy Spirit through Your Word. I have sinned against heaven and against You. (We pause for a moment of personal reflection and confession.) For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, I ask Your forgiveness. I believe Jesus lived for me and died for me to take away my sin. I also ask that by the power and grace of Your Holy Spirit, You would empower me to walk and live in the light of Jesus. Amen.

Pastor: Our God is gracious even as He is merciful. In Jesus, not only does He take away the punishment we deserve, He also gives us the forgiveness we don't deserve. And He is faithful, not only in forgiving our sins but also in blessing us with the power of His Spirit that we might live a new life. You are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Pastor: Father, we thank and praise You for all the gifts You have so freely and graciously given to us, especially the gifts of faith and forgiveness.

Congregation: We pray that You would use us to reach out to the people in our community who do not know You. Make us people of grace so that with our words and with our lives we bear witness to You.
