Pastor: We gather today around the message of the cross, Christ and Him crucified.

Congregation: And we worship in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: A long time ago through the prophet Micah the Lord God confronted His people with their sin. God had a case against His people, and through the prophet the Lord asked some very pointed questions. 'My people, what have I done to you? How have I burdened you? Answer Me." God also made it clear as to how His people should live. "And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God." (Micah 6:3, 8) That Word of the Lord now speaks to us, calling us to confess our sins with the promise of His forgiveness and the invitation to walk humbly with Him.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, I confess to You that I have fallen way short of how You have commanded me to live. I have not loved You with my whole heart. I have not loved my neighbor as myself. I have sinned in my thoughts. I have sinned with my words and with my deeds. For the sake of

Your Son, Jesus Christ, I seek Your forgiveness. Create a clean heart in me and renew me with Your Holy Spirit that I may walk humbly in faith with You.

Pastor: Listen to these words of grace and forgiveness from the very next chapter of Micah. "Who is a God like You, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of His inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy. You will again have compassion on us; You will tread our sins underfoot and hurl all our iniquities into the depths of the sea." (Micah 7:18-19) In Jesus Christ, we know that is all true. This is what God has done. In and through His Son, He has forgiven you and me of all our sins. May He continue to give us His Holy Spirit so that we can walk humbly in faith with Him.
