We will be taking up our noisy offering on **Sunday, February 19**th, for the **Pregnancy Resource Center.** Thank you for your support and your generous donations!







Celebrate World Day of Prayer on February 24

All are invited to join in this year's World Day of Prayer Service at First United Methodist Church (1107 Pine Cone Rd S, Sartell) on Friday, February 24, at 1:00pm. The World Day of Prayer celebration has a long history in the St. Cloud area with numerous local churches participating in this community event over the years.

Begun in 1927, World Day of Prayer is a worldwide ecumenical movement of Christian women who come together to observe a common day of prayer each year. It was founded on the idea that prayer and action are inseparable in the service of God's kingdom. This year's World Day of Prayer celebration is written by the women of Taiwan. The theme of the worship service "I Have Heard About Your Faith", based on the letter to the Ephesians, is an invitation to active listening, which is the ground of our prayers.
