### Confession and God's Forgiveness

Pastor: When the Lord appeared to Moses in the burning bush, He told Moses to "take off his shoes, for he was standing on holy ground." To take off his shoes would be a way for Moses to acknowledge his sinfulness in the presence of a holy God. Let's do that now by confessing our sins to our heavenly Father, seeking His grace and forgiveness for the sake of His Son, Jesus Christ.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, if I said to You that I have not sinned, the truth would not be in me. But in Your Word You assure me that if I confess my sins, You will be faithful and just and You will forgive my sins. It is because of Your promise and grace in Jesus that I confess to You that I have sinned against You with my thoughts and my words and my deeds. I have also failed to do that which was right. I am truly sorry for my sins, and I desire to live in a way that shows my

love for You. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, forgive my sins and renew me with the power of Your Holy Spirit that I may live out my love for You.


