And, Lent always meant the approach of spring, longer days, and the Minnesota Boys State High School Basketball tournament. Those three days of High School basketball played in Williams arena found me glued to the television set (channel 9 and Frank Buetel doing the play by play) with a dream that someday I would play on the floor and in the tournament. (A dream never realized.)

What are your memories of Lent?

I invite you to create some new memories with me. Come and join in our midweek service each Wednesday as we gather around the theme: "Understanding the Cross: This is why He came!" And before the service, come and join in some delicious soup/supper and Christian fellowship...and create some more memories of time with friends and church family.

Thankful for the old memories and looking forward to the new memories!

Treasurer's report was reviewed. Paul made a motion to accept the treasurer's report followed by a second from Joanny. Motion approved.

Properties Report: Keith Peterson reported that there would be a Spring Cleaning of the sanctuary before Easter. The parking lot has never been salted before but after the winter we have had with ice, salt will be added when it's plowed. Salt runs about \$200 a ton and we would use about ¼ ton each time. Still waiting on the bid from Astech for the parking lot. The next big project will be new carpet in the sanctuary. Also new windows will be installed this summer, in the 2 rooms down the hall from Pastors office.

Secretary's Report: The report was reviewed. An amendment was made to correct a spelling error. Motion to accept the minutes as amended by Colleen and seconded by Dave. Motion approved. **Pastoral Activity** Report: Kyle presented Pastor's report.

Old Business:

* **Call Process:** President Finnern presented a new list of Pastors to consider for a call. The Board decided to have a congregational meeting to allow the congregation to decide whether we consider a Seminarian or proceed with the list provided. The congregational meeting will take place on March 5th after service.

* **Easter Schedule**. Lenten Services Wednesday's February 22nd – March 29th 6:30...soup suppers 5-6:15. Maundy Thursday and Good Friday Service at 6:30. Easter Sunday services at 7am & 9:30am with breakfast severed from 8-9:15am. Easter Egg Hunt will be Saturday at 8th.

* Pastor Dave will be out of the office March 6th – March 13th . Pastor Paul Cloeter will fill in for the Wednesday and Sunday services.

* The Little Fall Circuit sent out a letter regarding funds for the 2024 LCMS Synodical Convention. We will follow their request for \$3.65 per communicant member reported in 2021.

* The Board had some discussion on the use and rental of the fellowship hall. There will be a revised rental contract drawn up.






