## Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: Hosanna! It means, "Lord, save us!" Jesus entered Jerusalem to do exactly that.

### Congregation: "Lord, save us!"

Pastor: Really, that is the only plea we can make as sinners before a holy and just God. Let's confess our sins and our need for Him, asking our heavenly Father to forgive us for the sake of His Son. Hosanna; Lord save us! Congregation: Lord, save me! For I have sinned against You with my thoughts and my words and my deeds. There are even sins I have done of which I am not aware. Forgive me also for my hidden faults. I am truly sorry for my sins. Hosanna! Lord, save me!

Pastor: That you and I might be forgiven of our sins is exactly why Jesus came.
