Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: One of the grand truths of the resurrection of Jesus is shared by Paul in Romans 4. Writing about Jesus, Paul stated this as fact. "He was raised again for our justification." Paul put that a little differently in 1 Corinthians 15. "If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins." Knowing and believing the truth of Scripture, that Jesus Christ did indeed rise from the dead, we come to our heavenly Father at His invitation to confess our sins and receive His forgiveness in Christ.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, I confess to you that I have sinned against You. I have broken each of Your Commandments. I have not loved You with my whole heart and I have not loved my neighbor as I have loved myself. I deserve only Your punishment, both now and forever. For the sake of Your Son, my risen Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, I pray and ask to be forgiven. 
