Invocation

Pastor: We begin with words from Psalm 148.

Congregation: Praise the Lord. Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the heights above. Christ is risen!

Pastor: Praise Him, all His angels, praise Him, all His heavenly hosts.

Congregation: Christ is risen! Praise Him, sun and moon, praise Him, all you shining stars.

Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: On the night of His resurrection, our risen Savior appeared to His disciples and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone his sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven." Within those words Jesus is inviting us to confess our sins and seek His forgiveness with the promise that He will bless us with the full forgiveness of our sins. We turn to Him now.

Congregation: Lord Jesus Christ, I confess that I am in need of Your forgiveness. I confess that I have "sinned against heaven and against You and am no longer worthy to be called Your child." (Luke 15:18-19) "Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. Create a new heart within me. Renew a steadfast spirit within me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and grant me a willing spirit to sustain me." (Psalm 51:2, 10, 12)

Pastor: God's mercy is this – that He doesn't give us what we deserve for our sins. His grace is this – that He gives us what we don't deserve: forgiveness! Because Jesus Christ lived a perfect life for us and suffered the death we deserved. And because He rose again on the third day, God declares us to be justified...to be forgiven! You and I are forgiven of all our sins in Jesus! He is risen!

Congregation: Hallelujah! Christ is risen indeed.

Prayer of the Day

Pastor: Heavenly Father, we praise You for Your great mercy that You have given us through the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

Congregation: When we go through trials in this life, strengthen us with the power of Your Holy Spirit so that our faith in You may be proved to be genuine and result in praise when Jesus Christ comes again.

Pastor: We ask this in His name. Amen.
