# Rice Area Community Spring Blood Drive




American Red Cross The spring Rice Area Blood Drive is coming up on **Monday**, **April 22**, **1:00** – **6:45** at Shepherd of the Pines

If you've been collecting things for the Youth Group Garage Sale: We have the garage sale in May; items can be brought to the church starting April 28th. Garage Sale items should be


