Together now, let's both confess and repent of our sins and receive the promised grace and forgiveness of our sins from our heavenly Father through Jesus Christ.

Pastor: "This is the promise for you and your children and for all who are far off – for all whom the Lord our God will call." (Acts 2:39) For the sake of Jesus Christ, God's Son, our sins have been forgiven. He has paid for our sins with His life, and He has risen from the dead to bring us that forgiveness. You are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.


Rice Area Community Spring Blood Drive
