Pastor: We begin our worship with the words of Psalm 67.

Congregation: "May God be gracious to us and bless us and make His face shine upon us."

Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: There's a little word in Psalm 67 that is used twice. It's the word "selah." It means in general to pause and reflect on what's been said in the previous verses. So, as we pause and reflect on our request of God to be gracious to us and to bless us, it will be good for us to have a "selah moment" and pause to reflect on our lives this past week. In particular, it will be good for us to reflect on our need for His grace and blessings in light of our sins. We take that moment now to confess our sins, that God, being true to His promise, will be gracious to us and forgive us all our sins for the sake of His Son, Jesus Christ.

Congregation: Father, in Your Word, You have promised that "if we confess our sins, You will be faithful and just and will cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Drawn by Your promise, I humbly come before You now with my brothers and sisters in Christ to seek Your grace. I need Your forgiveness, for I have sinned against You in thought and in word and in deed. I am truly sorry for my sins. Trusting only in Your promise, I pray that You will forgive me all my sins for the sake of Your Son, Who gave His life on behalf of all sinners. Renew me with the power of Your Holy Spirit, so that I may live in a way that brings You honor and glory. It is in the name of Jesus that I ask this. Amen.

Pastor: Jesus Christ not only lived a perfect life for you. He died for you. In living and dying for you, He paid for all of your sins. In Him and through faith in Him, you are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Indeed, God has answered our prayer "to be gracious to us and bless us and make His face shine upon us." Selah!
