Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: These are some of the most difficult words for us to say: "I'm sorry. I was wrong. Will you forgive me?" And yet, until we do speak those words and unless we do speak those words, we will not have peace. In a few moments we will hear King David admit to the difficulties of speaking those words as well as his realization that he did need to speak those words, especially to God. "When I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long...my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer. Then I acknowledged my sin to You and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the Lord' – and You forgave the guilt of my sin." (Psalm 32) Let's each sincerely speak the words now and seek God's forgiveness in Jesus Christ.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, I am truly sorry for my sins of thought and word and deed that I have committed this past week. I offer no excuses, for there are none. I was wrong, and it grieves me that I have offended You and caused harm to others. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, I ask that You forgive not only my sin, but also the guilt of my sin. I also ask for the grace and power of Your Holy Spirit, that I might walk more closely with You and live in a way that reflects and shares Your unconditional love. Amen.
