A couple of weeks ago, they paid off the land they have purchased, which means they are now saving toward their building. Their property is located by the Field of Dreams ball field.

Due to the COVID pandemic, they have been unable to meet at Rice Elementary as the school is not having outside organizations meet on their property. During this summer as "In-Person" worship resumed at Bridge Church, they met in a tent on their property. However, they will not be able to meet in a tent outside for much longer in our climate.

Our church's Board of Lay Ministry met with Bridge Church's Board in August to see how we can help them. They are in need of a building to use temporarily and the Holy Spirit used our church as a way to answer this prayer. In August, we had a "Town Hall" after church on Sunday to talk with members of our congregation about us helping Bridge Church.

As I've been processing and praying for our opportunity to show them hospitality, I have a couple of points I want to share.

First, we offer gratitude to our members and to God for giving us this building. This building was built to be used for God's purposes and lots of sacrifice went into this.

Second, we want our facility to be a blessing to others. God has given us a beautiful sanctuary and we want others to be blessed by this.

I recognize that this is not something that we *have* to do. However, I ask that you consider how we can be a blessing to others in our community. Additionally, I pray that this would be a good witness to those in our area. We are showing our community that we want to offer hospitality and help each other. And I pray that God would continue to use us for his purposes!

We are thankful for all of the people who are faithfully providing financially to the church, we are doing better financially than last year.

Properties – Keith reported that the committee met to plan projects around the church. They will be taking down a couple of dead trees. The picnic tables have been stained. The fire ring will be repositioned this fall. Keith will be soliciting bids for seal coating the parking lot. Jeff does a wonderful job at keeping our building clean.

Secretary's Report – Wayne made a motion to accept the Secretary's report as written, seconded by Deb. Motion carried.

Pastoral Activity Report – Pastor David reported on his activities in the month of July including baptisms, meeting new people in the community and calling members. Pastor David shared the summary results of the survey on fall planning which was sent out the previous day with the BOLM, it was very consistent with what was heard at the town hall meeting.

COVID update – A reminder that our church is operating under the executive order for people to wear masks unless a medical condition prevents them.

Policy Binders – Deb made a motion to table this topic to our next in person meeting. Janet seconded. Motion carried.

Chamber of Commerce Sign – Wayne asked about the sign the commerce was installing. We gave the chamber the money to advertise on the sign. We have not had any update recently.

Leader's comments – Deb commented that the change in communion distribution procedure was good.

Motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Wayne, seconded by Janet. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 9:05 pm.

In Acts 6:1-9 as the Apostles were in need of others to help in the ministry they encouraged the believers to choose those who are known to be full of the spirit and wisdom.

In keeping with this advice from scripture, Article 4 of our Constitution By Laws says, "The Board of Lay Ministry of the church shall be composed of 7 communicant members (male and female), and the treasurer of the church, elected at the annual meeting of the church. They shall be people who have proven faithful to the Lord and His church. They shall also have been communicant members of the church for at least 2 years prior to sitting on the board and shall not be ministry staff members or employees of the church. They also should be people who attend worship faithfully and are involved in ongoing Bible study and a committed life of growing discipleship. Members of the board shall serve three-year terms established on a staggered basis, and may not serve more than two consecutive terms. The Senior-Pastor - Director of Ministries shall be an ex-officio member of the Board of Lay Ministry."

There are three spots open for election on the Board of Lay Ministry. They are currently held by Janet Maleska and Kyle Hackett finishing their first terms, also Sarah Anderson finishing her second term. There is also the Treasurer spot open with Curt Kvamme finishing his second term. Please pray that the Lord will guide us to the people He wants to fill these positions. As you are led to someone, contact that person to see if they are willing to serve, and then submit their name in writing and place it in the nomination box on the counter in the church lobby. The nomination box will be available on the counter between September 27<sup>th</sup> and October 11<sup>th</sup>. The congregation will elect four people from the list of nominations at the annual congregational meeting on Sunday, November 22nd. 


