Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: Today's Gospel lesson are the Beatitudes spoken by Jesus as He began what we know as The Sermon on the Mount. The first four of those beatitudes speak of being poor in spirit, mourning, being meek, and about those who hunger and thirst for righteousness. In reality, those are all part and parcel of what it is to be repentant and truly sorry for our sin. The promise that is given can be summed up with these simple words. God promises to forgive us our sins as we come to Him, and that for the sake of His Son, Jesus. So it is we confess our sins now. Congregation: Heavenly Father, it is with a heart broken by the knowledge of my sin that I come to You seeking Your forgiveness. I am deeply saddened by my sinful thoughts and words and deeds. I have nothing to boast about before You and no reason of my own making to offer to satisfy Your justice or Your holiness. I hunger and thirst for the righteousness and forgiveness that You alone can offer and give through the once and for all times payment for sin made by Your Son, Jesus Christ. For His sake, fill me, be merciful to me, purify my heart that I may see You and be called one of Your redeemed and forgiven children. Amen.

Pastor: In the words of Jesus, "Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven." The reward is that earned for you by Jesus with His perfect life and with His innocent suffering and death on your behalf. Your sins are forgiven! And in Jesus, you do have eternal life, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
