Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: In Psalm 90 we are told this about our sins and God's knowledge of them. "You have set our iniquities before You, our secret sins in the light of Your presence." (Psalm 90:8) Even though He already knows all our sins and each of our sins, our Heavenly Father desires for us to confess our sins to Him, more for our sake than for His. Confession is good for the soul. Being forgiven is even better. Knowing Him to be a gracious and forgiving God as revealed to us in Jesus Christ, let us make a sincere confession of our sins and seek His forgiveness.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, You have seen all of my sins, even the ones I have tried to hide. You know them all. I am truly sorry for them. I am sorry that I have tried to hide them from You. All I can say to You and ask of You is this: "God, be merciful to me, a sinner."

Pastor: Let these words of Psalm 90 remind you of Jesus. "You have set our iniquities before You." Even as our heavenly Father saw our sins, so in His grace He placed all of our sins upon His Son, Jesus. Isaiah tells us: "The Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all." So it is that in and through Jesus, your sins have been paid for. In Jesus, your sins have been forgiven. In Jesus, God's favor rests upon you.

Congregation: Amen.

Pastor: Lord Jesus, You are King and You rule over all.

Congregation: Reign in our hearts, Lord. Bless us with Your Spirit that we might live in a way that brings You honor and glory.
