And there is no answer to the question of "where would we be now without you?" other than to say we wouldn't want to be there.

So, to all of our veterans and to each of our veterans, especially to you who are my brothers and sisters in Christ at Shepherd of the Pines, please accept this as one person's heartfelt words of "Thank You!" for your faithful service to our country.


