Pastor: Today as we enter into the season of Advent we worship against the backdrop of these words of Jesus in the Gospel lesson. "So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect Him." (Matthew 24:44)

Congregation: "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day the Lord will come." (Matthew 24:42)

Pastor: So it is that we begin our worship with the name that was placed upon us at our Baptism, when we were given the gift of faith in Jesus, the One Who is to come.

Congregation: We worship as His redeemed and forgiven children in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: This is God's promise. If we confess our sins, He will be faithful and just, and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9) Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

Congregation: O Almighty God, merciful Father, I, a poor, miserable sinner, confess unto You all my sins and iniquities with which I have ever offended You and justly deserved Your temporal and eternal punishment. But I am heartily sorry for them and sincerely repent of them, and I pray that You of Your boundless mercy and for the sake of the holy, innocent, bitter sufferings and death of Your beloved Son, Jesus Christ, be gracious and merciful to me, a poor, sinful being.

Pastor: In the mercy of almighty God, Jesus Christ was given to die for us, and for His sake God forgives us all our sins. By His grace, He has removed your sins from you as far as the east is from the west. With His grace, He remembers them no more. You are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Congregation: Amen.
