Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: Using the words of Psalm 32: Blessed is the person whose transgressions are forgiven, Whose sins are covered.

Congregation: Blessed is the one whose sin the Lord does not count against them and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

Pastor: When I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer. Selah.
