Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: Echoing the words of John the Baptist on this first Sunday in Lent. "The time has come; the Kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!" Together let us confess our sins and affirm our desire to repent of them, to change our sinful ways of thinking and speaking and doing. Only God's grace and forgiveness in Jesus Christ enables us to do this so that we might live each day as His forgiven and redeemed children.

Congregation: Father in heaven, I cannot keep silent about my sins. The Holy Spirit has convicted me with Your Word and has brought me to acknowledge my sins to You. I cannot cover them up. I confess my transgressions to You – my sins of thought and word and deed. For the sake of Your Son,

Jesus Christ, forgive the guilt of my sin. I pray that Your Spirit will instruct me and teach me in the way that I should go. I trust in Your unfailing love.

Pastor: Believe this good news. Your Heavenly Father has forgiven you all your sins because His Son took your sins to the cross and there paid the full price for them with His blood and with His life. "The blood of Jesus Christ, God's Son, cleanses us from all sin." You are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

"The Women of Lent"

It began with Eve. It continued with Ruth. We also can see connections to it in the lives of the prophetess Anna, Martha and her sister Mary, in a Samaritan woman, an anonymous woman, and finally, in the life of Jesus' mother, Mary. Let's call them "The Women of Lent", as they each had something to do with God's promise to Eve, that someday He would send a Savior to redeem the world from its fall into sin.

This will be the focus of a series of dialogue messages for our Lenten services, beginning with Ash Wednesday, February 14th, and continuing through Good Friday, March 29th. I have a favor to ask my sisters in Christ at SOTP. I would like to have at least two of you join me each week in presenting the message as part of a dialogue message. You would serve as a panel to help bring out insights into each of the women we will be studying. Your preparation would involve spending some time in advance with the story of the woman we are focusing on each week, and then joining me to talk about and share how these women help us each to see our Savior's passion and cross a little more clearly.
