Pastor: In the name of God the Father who so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son;

Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: Paul has some pretty blunt words to share with us in today's New Testament reading from Ephesians. He writes that we "were dead in our transgressions and sins...that we have followed the ways of this world and the devil...that all of us lived among them...gratifying the cravings of our sinful nature and following its desires." And then he wrote this one word: "But."

What follows that one word will be shared with you in a few moments. For now, that one word leads us to be able to confess our sins to our heavenly Father and seek His forgiveness for the sake of His Son Jesus.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, I must confess that Paul has written the truth about me. I have been dead in my transgressions and sins. I have followed the ways of this world of the devil. I have gratified the cravings of my sinful nature and followed its desires. In all of this, I have sinned against You. I am truly sorry for my sinfulness and for my sins. I seek Your forgiveness in Jesus Christ.

Pastor: Now it's time to hear the words Paul wrote which followed "But." "But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions – it is by grace you have been saved...it is the gift of God." That gift is in Jesus, and it is the forgiveness of all your sins He gained for you with His perfect life and His innocent suffering and death on our behalf. In and through Jesus, you are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of The Holy Spirit.

Congregation: Amen.

A continued zeal for the study of His Word, the Bible, is necessary for the growth of any Christian congregation. Thus, the Word of God will be taught and studied in full measure and His Word shall be the <u>rule and norm</u> of this congregation's faith and life.

To that end, our every effort and energy will be used in motivating, training, and putting to use our time, and talents and treasures to <u>Make Disciples</u>.
