Pastor: We worship in the name placed upon us in baptism, the name of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: In today's Old Testament reading the prophet Jeremiah speaks on behalf of God. He wrote: "This is what the Lord declares. The time is coming when I will make a new covenant with My people. It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they broke My covenant." Against the backdrop of those words, we make confession of our own sin.

Congregation: Heavenly Father, like the children of Israel, we too, have broken Your covenant. We have not lived according to Your Word. Each of us must personally say and confess, "I have sinned against You in thought and in word and in deed. I have not followed Your law with my mind or with my heart." Yet, in Your Son, Jesus Christ, You have declared Yourself to be a gracious God, willing to forgive our wickedness and forget our sinfulness for His sake. Truly sorry for my sins, it is in His name that I seek Your forgiveness.

Pastor: God is so gracious! He has made a new covenant with us in and with His Son. Through the working of His Holy Spirit, He has made that covenant known to us. These are the very words He gave to the prophet Jeremiah stating His new covenant. "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more." In keeping with that covenant I therefore announce this good news to all of us: for the sake of Jesus Christ, God's Son, our sins are forgiven!

Congregation: Amen.

Prayer of the Day

Pastor: Father, we praise You for Your grace and mercy, for who You are, a God "slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love."

Congregation: We pray that the Holy Spirit would put Your law in our minds and write it on our hearts so that we may live faithfully as Your people.
