#### Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: Today's Old Testament reading is from Exodus 20, the giving of the Ten Commandments. This is the Law of God, and it does two things. First, it shows us our sin. Secondly, in showing us our sin, it also shows us our need for a Savior. Listen to this summary of the Commandments given by Jesus. "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart. You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Congregation: Heavenly Father, I have not loved You with all my heart. I have not loved my neighbor as I have loved myself. I have broken each of Your Commandments with my thoughts and with my words and with my deeds. I see my sin, and in seeing my sin I see my need for a Savior. Broken by Your Law, and yet, invited by Your grace, I seek Your forgiveness of all my sin for the sake of Jesus, Your Son. I

## trust in Your Word and promise, that His blood will cleanse me from all unrighteousness.

Pastor: The Law breaks us. The Gospel heals us. The Gospel shows us our Savior, and He is Jesus Christ, God's Son. He took our place on the cross and died for our sins. Before doing so, He also lived a perfect life for us. In Him and through Him, we are forgiven all our sins, and by the work of the Holy Spirit we wear the righteousness of Christ. Go in peace – you are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
