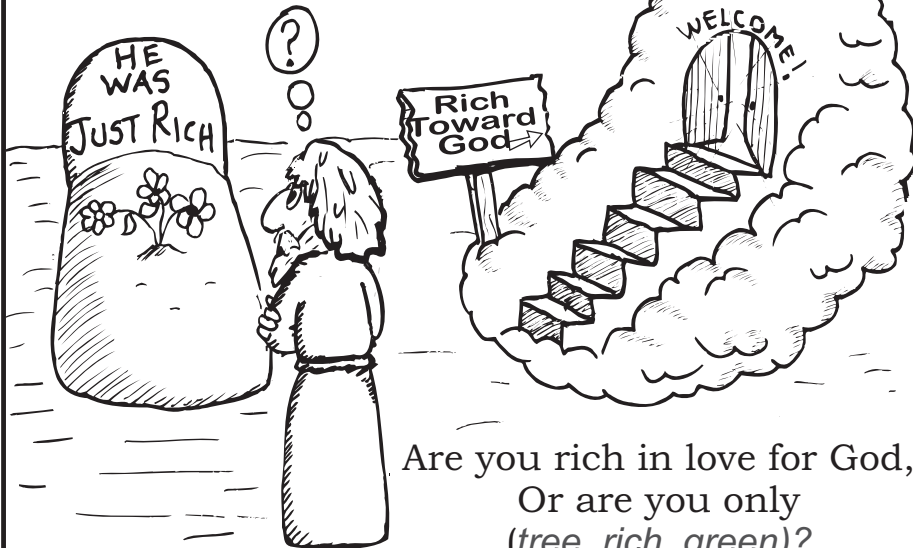


Then suddenly he heard a voice,

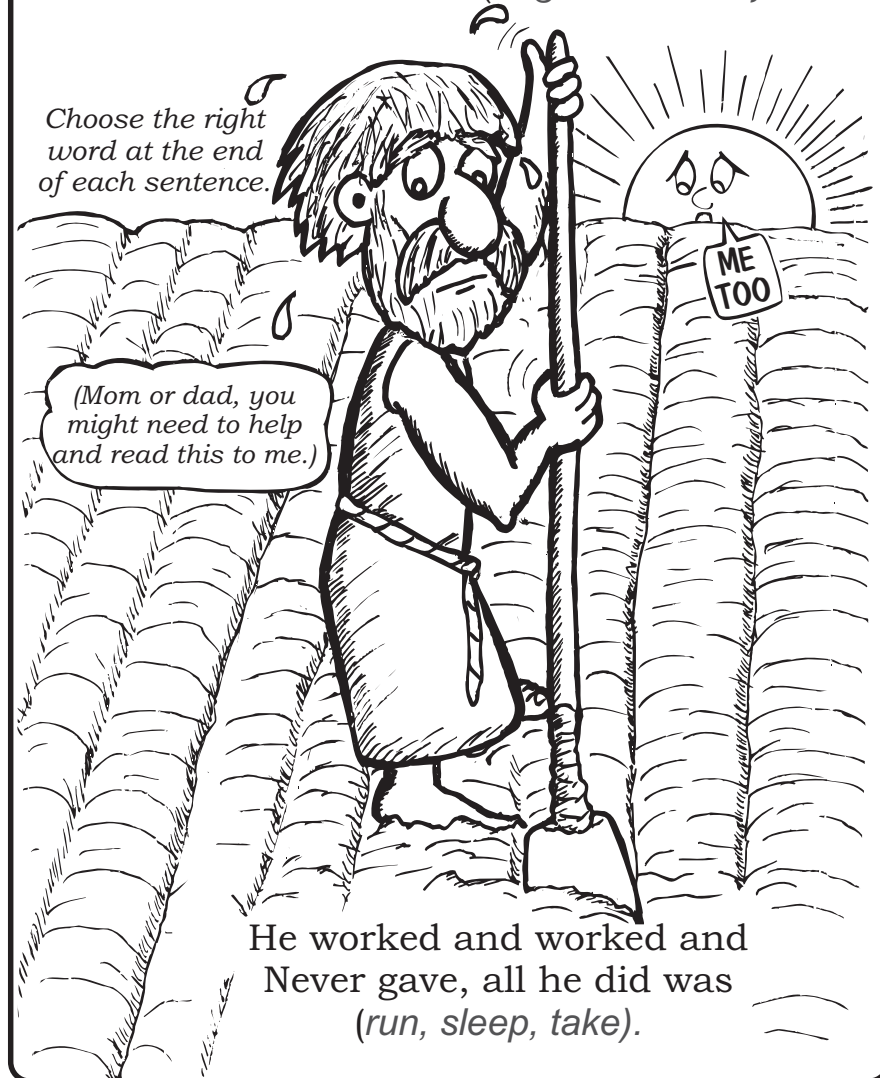

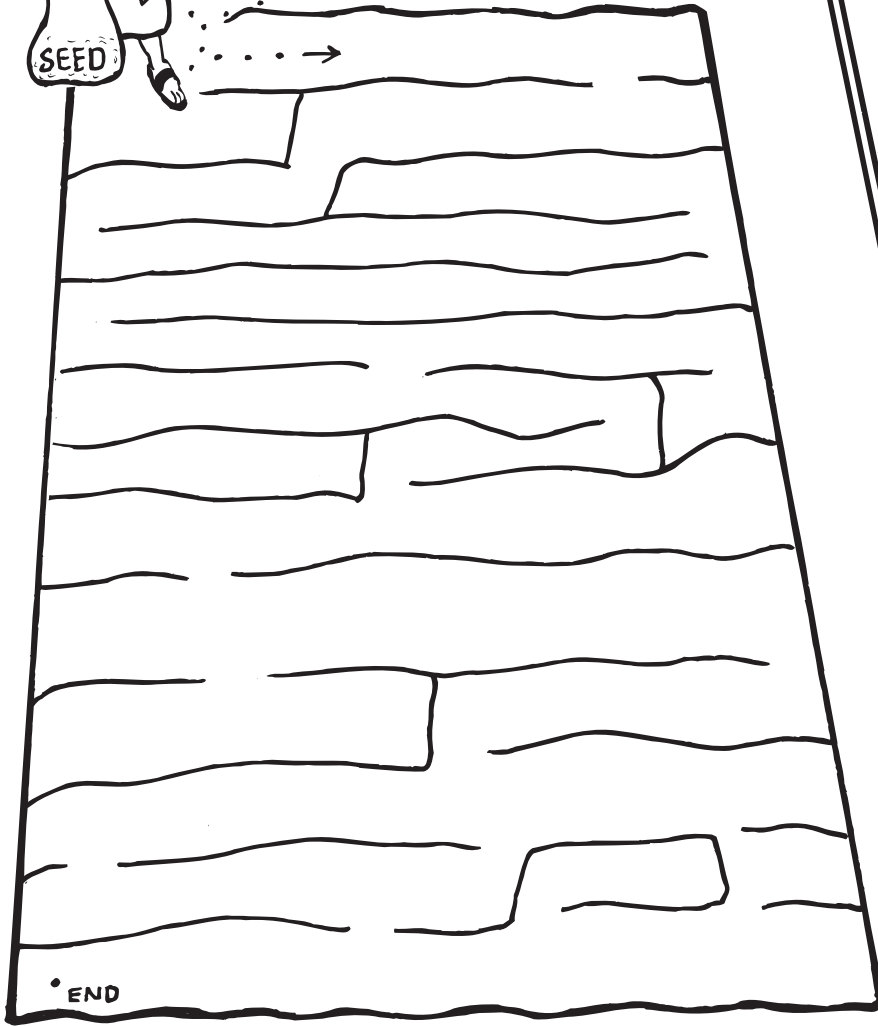


He worked and worked and

them by drawing plants.



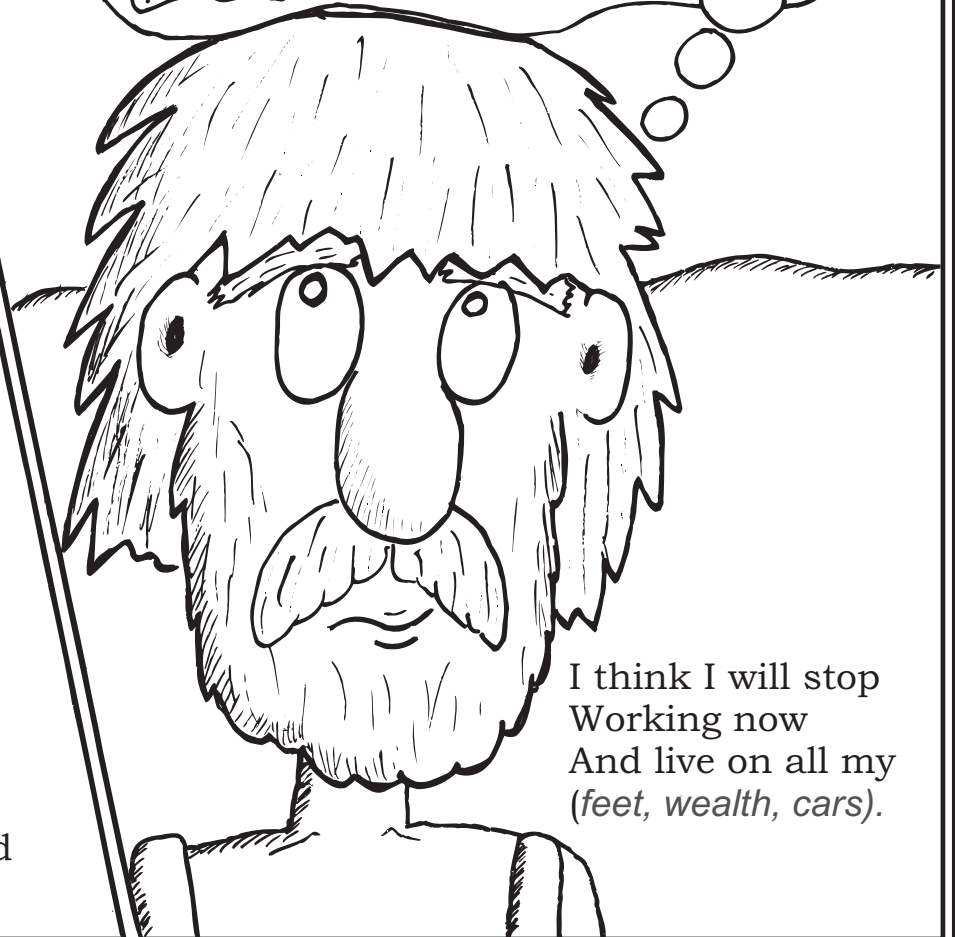
