The Minnesota North Branch of Orphan Grain Train has sent one semi-load of potatoes from a supplier/donor near Long Prairie. This load was 43,000 lbs. The potatoes have been shipped to Ysleta Mission at

El Paso, Texas. Distribution is done at the Mission for those in need through churches in Texas and Mexico. Ysleta Mission helps feed the hungry, nurtures their ministries, and educates the leaders in 11 affiliated mission sites in El Paso and northern Mexico. **The cost for this load of potatoes was \$3296.00 and shipping cost will be about \$3.650.00**
