done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are proved right when You speak and justified when You judge. Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me. Hide Your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity. Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast Spirit within me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and grant me a willing spirit to sustain me. (Psalm 51:1-5, 9,10, 12)

Pastor: We turn now to the One John the Baptist pointed to...Jesus, the Christ. "Behold the Lamb of God Who takes away the sins of the world" (John 1:29). Jesus did that by living a perfect life in our stead and then dying on the cross to pay for our sins. "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace."
