Dear friends in Christ,

It has long been one of my favorite holidays...the 4th of July! I have a ton of memories of past family celebrations of the day which we always spent in Annandale. Watching the parade from my Grandma's front yard. Taking in the carnival. Family time at the cabin on Pleasant Lake. And of course, the fireworks! I'm sure you have a similar list. After all, it is the 4th ... a great American tradition!

So, let's pause for a moment to focus on what the 4th is all about. It's all about The Declaration of Independence. It's about the birth of our nation. It's about who we are..."one nation, under God..."

I know from listening to many of you that there are a lot of genuine and well-founded concerns about where things are at in the U.S.A. today, especially with regards to being a nation "under God." I share those concerns.

"I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone – for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good and pleases God our Savior." (1 Timothy 2:1-3)

Suggestion #2. Be involved. Speak up. Speak out. Vote. Be the salt for and in our society and nation. Be the light. "You are the salt of the earth...You are the light of the world...In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven." (Matthew 5:13, 14, 16)

And the word of assurance? God's got this! He is still in control. He is still God and Lord over all, including our country...even when as a country we are a far cry from acknowledging it.

Listen to these words from Psalm 11. They speak volumes to the time and place in which you and I find ourselves living. "When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do? (cf. Suggestions 1 and 2) The Lord is in His holy temple; the Lord is on His heavenly throne." (Psalm 11: 3-4)




