Jesus The Master Storyteller

It's no secret that stories have a unique power that other genres of speech or writing cannot match. During a trial, a good lawyer wouldn't only offer a solid argument full of facts but would also tie these details together to form a greater narrative. The best movies are not necessarily ones that have the best visual effects or even acting but have the best story. We've all seen movies that had great special effects, but were forgotten because there was not a whole lot for us to identify with.

We all relate to stories, which is why God communicates to people through story. The Bible is full of stories that teach us about God and ourselves. When Moses wrote Genesis chapter 3, imagine what it would look like if Moses instead simply listed theological facts about sin and temptation.

Having a list of doctrine points is helpful in certain circumstances, but overall, it wouldn't bring more clarity to the text. Instead, stories allow us to enter into the greater truths and allow us to learn about God in new perspectives.

Some of the most famous stories in the Bible are Jesus' parables, which allow us to discover greater truths about God's Kingdom. These parables are fictional, in the sense that they are not historical, but they are true stories. In fact, some of the greatest truths about God can only be expressed in story.

For instance, Jesus talks about how God the Father loves us in a few different places, but when he tells the Parable of the Prodigal Son, we see the lengths God the Father would go to save us and to welcome us into his family.

In another place, Jesus tells us that God forgives the debt sinners have, but when he tells us the Parable of the Unmerciful Servant we are brought into this story as the servant who had a debt so great his entire family would be sold into slavery. When we see the servant get his debt forgiven but then immediately goes out and accosts someone who owed him a little amount, we feel the bite that the story has, since we know all too well what it feels like to be that servant.

These stories are not literal stories, of actual historic people, but that doesn't mean that they're not real. These stories are incredibly real and convey God's truth that has a surprising punch to it.

This summer, we will have a sermon series on parables that will allow us to be challenged and discover deeper truths about God's kingdom. I love the parables and I pray that you will be blessed.
