Right now many in America are facing difficulties in terms of mental health. This includes depression, anxiety, guilt, loneliness and fatigue. This includes school aged kids who have not really been able to spend time with their friends at school or the playground, but this also includes many adults as well. For many of us, it's hard enough to find the strength to take care of ourselves much less others in our lives.

Most of us probably didn't consider ourselves "caretakers" before, but in times of crises, we want to make sure that our elderly relatives are protected and watched over. Likewise, we care for our children and younger family members who are having to do school at home and so forth. I'm seeing headlines about how many Americans are having are having issues with mental health, but recently there have been more research coming out about the exhaustion and burnout of caretakers.

This is something that needs to be noted and not overlooked. It's easy, as a caretaker, to ignore this aspect as we want to serve and help the more vulnerable in our lives. However, if you fly on airplanes, they tell you to put your oxygen mask on before others around you. As a father, I initially objected to this, since my kids are more important than I am. If I'm told to take care of myself first, isn't that being selfish?

The reason for this is that if I were not to put on my oxygen mask first, then not only would I not be ok, but neither would others around me. I would not be able to help them. As a caretaker, I want to help others and in times of fatigue and burnout, God invites us to come rest in his arms and indeed it is with him that we have our strength.

This Lent I invite you to not look to our own strength and abilities but to rely on God, who alone is our strength. The Psalmist says this in Psalm 28.

- Praise be to the LORD, for he has heard my cry for mercy.
- The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and he helps me. My heart leaps for joy,
 - and with my song I praise him.
- The LORD is the strength of his people, a fortress of salvation for his anointed one.
- Save your people and bless your inheritance; be their shepherd and carry them forever.

As we look to God and rely on Him as our strength, I pray that you would find your rest with Him!

Pastoral Activity Report for January: 5 Sunday Worship services in-person and online, 3 Wednesday evening Confirmation Classes, 1 Baptism, plus Regular meetings with Julie and BOLM and 1 Circuit/District Meeting.

Hosted Rice Chamber of Commerce Meeting, Attended the Circuit Forum at Trinity Lutheran as well as the Mission and Congregational Outreach Zoom Meeting. His sermon "God's Workmanship" was taped by "Main Street Living" to air March 14, 2021 (Watch the Sunday Bulletin for more information.)

There were no Hospital or Shut-in visits because of Covid restrictions.

Pastor gave an update on family issues.

OLD BUSINESS:

Covid Update... Churches now are allowed to have 150 people or 50% of capacity in attendance at services. Recently inperson attendance has been up to 45 people. At 50% capacity we are now allowed 150. (Full capacity of sancturay plus fellowship area is maximum 300.) There have also been about 40 people participating on Sunday mornings on the internet. We anticipate an increase in in-person attendance as people get the vaccine and become more confident. We can add more chairs back into the Sanctuary to achieve 50% capacity for Palm Sunday and Easter, with overflow easily accommodated in the fellowship hall with large screen projection of the service.

We anticipate continuing with one Service each Sunday through the summer.

Bridge Church: Original Contract was for 3 months, thru January. Kyle will follow up with Bridge Church, Deb will check with Community Ed to see if the school is opening for outside groups.






