God is active in our lives and gives us breath in our lungs, which are then used to declare the praises of God!

I'm certainly not perfect at this, but it's in times like these that we learn how to praise God at all seasons in our lives. To God be the glory, whether he gives to us abundance or shortage from his hand!


Jeremiah 29:11 New International
