Pastor: Here is where we are at in what is called the Church Year Calendar. This Sunday and next Sunday are the last two Sundays of the 2021-2022 Church Year. The Sunday after Thanksgiving will be the First Sunday in Advent and the beginning of a new Church Year. with this in mind, and with the general theme for the next two Sunday's being the Return of Jesus Christ and Judgment Day, it is good for us to confess our sins and to repent of them and to seek God's grace and forgiveness in Jesus Christ.
