Pastor: We worship in the name of the God Who has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and in baptism brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. (Colossians 1:13-14)

Confession and Forgiveness

Pastor: This is the Last Sunday of the Church Year, and we call it "Christ the King" Sunday. The Gospel lesson for today takes us to the cross and the crucifixion of Jesus. The sign over His head that day read, "This is the King of the Jews." (Luke 23:38) Later, moments after Jesus had died, a centurion soldier remarked, "Surely this was a righteous man." (Luke 23:47) That all happened so that sinners such as you and me could come to our God, confess our sins, and receive His forgiveness.

Congregation: Most merciful God, I confess that I am by nature sinful and unclean. I have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what I have done and by what I have left undone. I have not loved You with my whole heart; I have not loved my neighbors as I have loved myself. I justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on me. Forgive me, renew me, and lead me, so that I may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

Pastor: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As an ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. **Congregation: Amen. "He has rescued us and brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in Whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins." (Colossians 1:13-14)**
