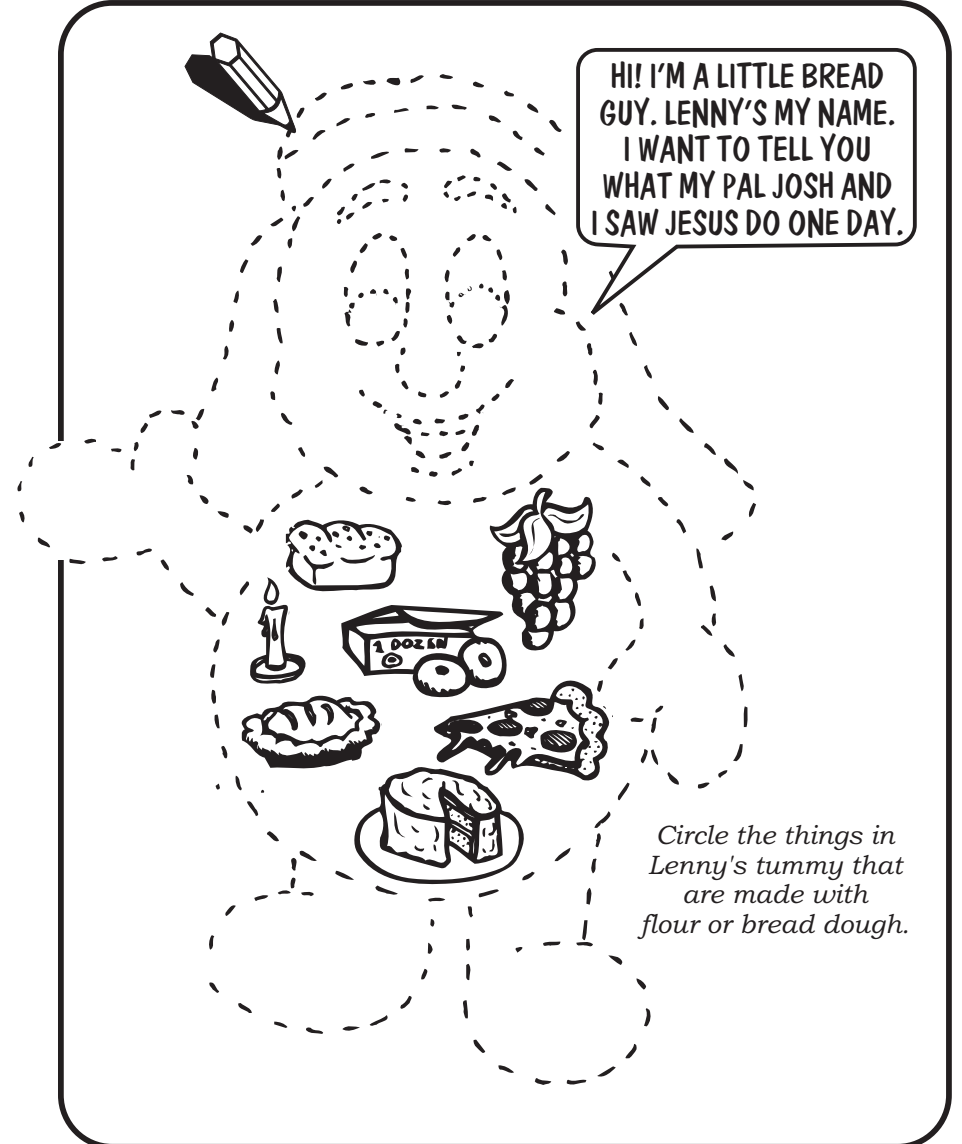

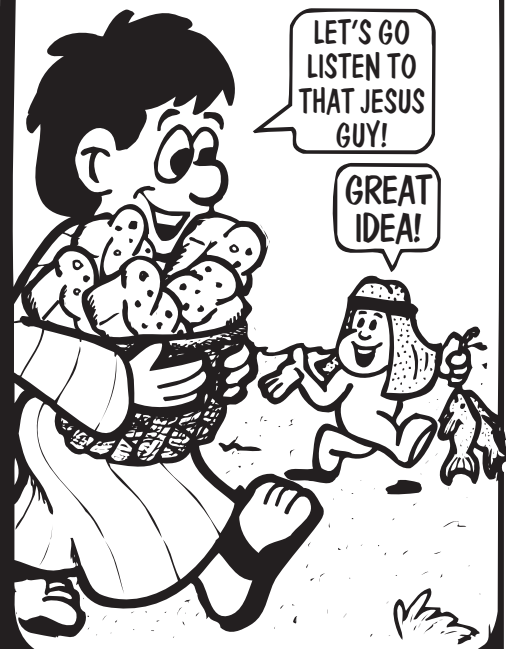
They will only catch fish that look like this: How many are there?

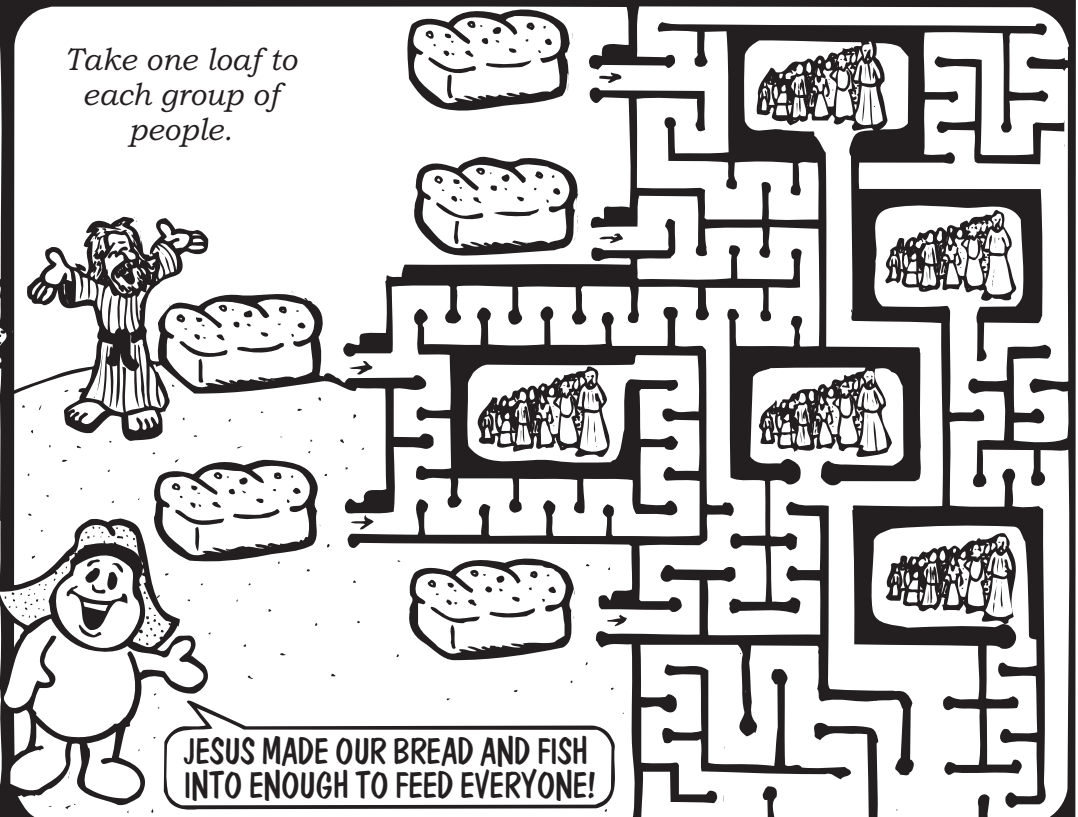
